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THE CAUSE

In the juncture of rapidly spreading of COVID-19 pandemic in India and nationwide lockdown impacted adversely thousands of extremely vulnerable groups These groups have been facing acute problems of getting food due to declaration of lockdown. Majority of these groups are at highest risk of spreading the virus for searching livelihoods. We ensured steady supply of dry ration kits, cooked food items and sanitation kits to these families to survive during the crisis situation.

OUR EFFORTS ...

- A total 23,250 KG Of food grains have been distributed among the affected families
- Provided timely relief support to 1500+ needy people of Angul and Deogarh districts in Odisha.
- Provided dry Ration kit Support to 1250 families and 500 hygiene kits to affected population.
- Facilitated 179 needy families to receive Government's Relief and Response Support programme.
- Conducted 25 COVID Awareness Camps on Hand washing & Social Distancing in various locations.
